## WELCOME, KIM HOOKS!

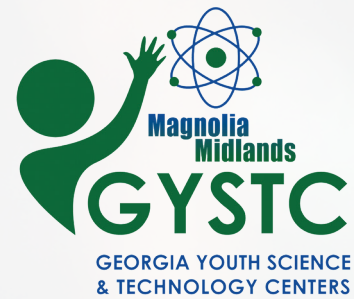
We are thrilled with the addition of Kim Hooks to our Magnolia Midlands Georgia Youth Science & Technology Center.

science education and will serve as part-time STEM Teacher for Magnolia Midlands.

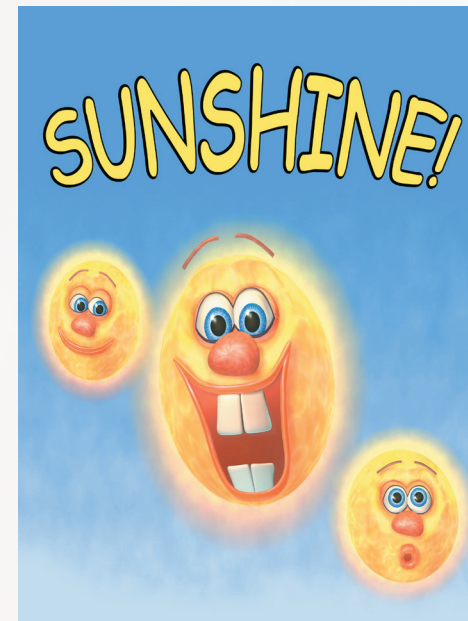
She is married to Evans Hooks, and they have two grown children, Addison and Susannah.

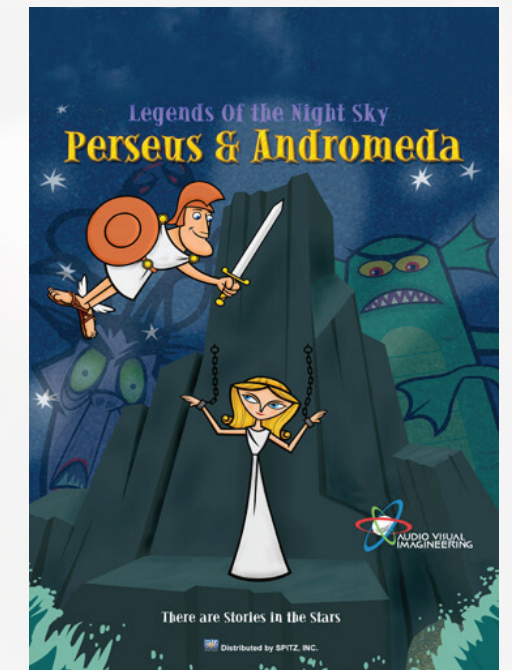


### Legends of the Night Sky: Perseus & Andromeda
