## Deal: Team to combat risks of Ebola should the need arise

Advisory group comprised of leaders in health and research communities, state agencies

Gov. Nathan Deal today named the members of the Georgia Ebola Response Team, which was created by <u>executive</u> <u>order</u> to assess current state health and emergency management procedures and produce necessary recommendations to minimize any potential impact of the disease in Georgia.
