System Minimums for Dual Enrollment Admission¹	
•	3.0 High School GPA
•	Evidence the student is on-track for completing high school graduation requirements and the RHSC
•	Parent/guardian consent

Dual Enrollment students may only enroll in an English or mathematics course if they exempt placement in corequisite Learning Support.
