Memo on Changes to Additional Institutional Requirements:

Effective Fall 2022, in response to the proposed new course Wellness 1000, a change to the "Additional Institutional Requirements" is necessary. This would include changing the curriculum hour requirements in this area from four credit hours (a 2 credit hour Health course, and two one credit hour PE courses) to two credit hours (the 2 credit hour Wellness 1000 course). This would reduce the overall graduation credit hour requirement from 64 credit hours to 62 credit hours for all AS and AA degrees. This would also require making changes to the Catalog on pg 47, 56, 57, 59, and 64. It is recommended to leave the HLTH and PHED courses in the catalog in the event we ever need to teach them.

Associate Degree Programs and Transfer Pathways

EGSC offers both associate degree programs and transfer pathways.

Associate of Arts and Associate of Science Programs: Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degree Hograms are programs with disciplinary distinction which provide the two years of course work in a discipline area. These degree programs may also be used as the first two years of course work toward the completion of a baccalaureate degree it a four-year institution. The programs with disciplinary distinction lead to the Associate of Arts (A.A.) or Associate of Science (A.S.) degree. Students in these degree programs follow the Core Curriculum established by the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia. The Core Curriculum is designed to facilitate the transfer of credit among he schools within the University System. The Core consists of 42 hours. There is an additional Area F requirement of 18-?1 hours in the student's chosen area of study

Area A 9 hours in Basic Skills (English and Mathematics)

Area B 4 hours of Institutional Option Courses 6 hours of Humanities and Fine Arts Area C

11 hours Science, Mathematics and Technology Area D

12 hours Social Sciences Area E
