Three different planetarium shows were shown during the event. Guests of all ages enjoyed the Christmas themed shows including a holiday sing-along show.

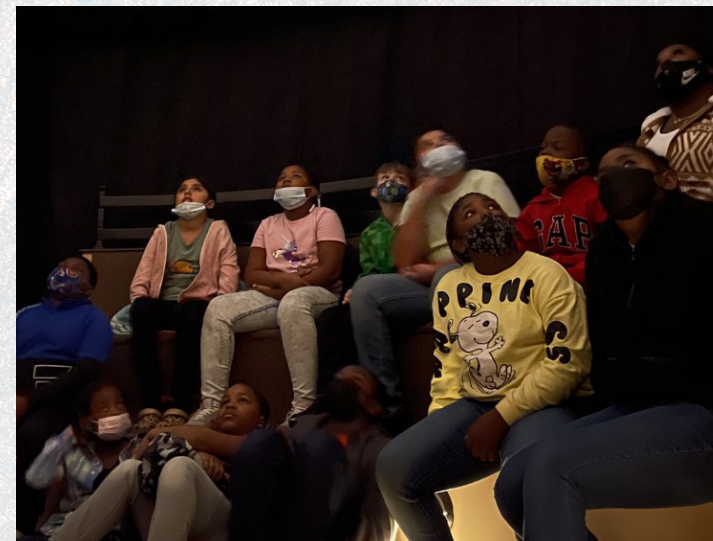
Bob the Bobcat, Miss East Georgia State College, and one of Santa's elves greeted guests and took photos around the Christmas tree.
