

Board of Regents' Changes to Area A of the Core Curriculum (July 2010)

Fall 2010: New entering freshmen students who have earned 60 hours but have not completed both Area A communication skills (ENGL 1101 & 1102) and quantitative skills (MATH 1001, 1101, 1111 or MATH 1113) must enroll in the next course necessary to make progress toward completing this Area in every semester in which they take classes.

Fall 2011: New entering freshmen students who have earned 45 hours but have not completed these same requirements must enroll in the next course necessary to make progress toward completing Area A in every semester in which they take classes.

Fall 2012: New entering freshmen students who have earned 30 hours but have not completed these same requirements must enroll in the next course necessary to make progress toward completing Area A in every semester in which they take classes.

For students with Learning Support (LS) requirements in reading or writing or math, taking the required LS course(s) counts as making progress toward completing Area A.
