HOW TO APPLY: Applicants to East Georgia College must submit the following:

1. ___ A properly completed and signed official application for admission.
2. ___ A \$20 non-refundable application fee.
3. ___ In addition, the following documents are required for consideration for admission: (Use this form as a checklist.)
(Applications and supporting documents submitted to the College become the property of the College and will not be returned to the applicant or sent to another institution.)

A. Freshman: *(a student who has graduated from an accredited high school, or completed the GED, and has less than 30 semester hours of transferable college credit)*

1. ___ Students should request an official high school transcript be sent by their appropriate school official to the EGC Admissions Office.
2. ___ SAT and/or ACT scores are no longer required for admission to EGC, however if a student scores 430 or higher on the verbal section of the SAT or 400 on the math section of the SAT, or 17 or higher on the English section of the ACT and 17 or higher on the Math section of the ACT and are not CPC deficient in English or Math they will be exempt from the placement exam. Students who have met these SAT and/or ACT scores should request official SAT and/or ACT scores be sent to EGC by their counselor or from Educational Testing Service.
3. ___ Freshmen applicants who possess a General Educational Development Diploma (GED) must submit an official copy of their GED test score report to the East Georgia College Office of Admissions.
4. ___ Freshmen who have attended college should request an official transcript be sent directly to the EGC Admissions Office from EACH college attended (including technical). Transferring freshmen must also be eligible to return immediately to the last college attended.
5. ___ Joint Enrollment/Early Admission/Accel students must have a minimum combined score of 970 on the SAT (or ACT equivalent), minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in academic subjects, written approval (joint enrollment) or written recommendation (early admission) from the high school principal, and written consent of the parent or guardian (if the student is a minor). Students taking advantage of the Accel program should also submit the Accel Program Application. A minimum score of 530 V is required for enrollment in college level English courses, a minimum score of 530 M is required for enrollment in college level Math courses.
6. ___ Students who have not attended high school or college within the previous five years and have earned fewer than 30 transferable semester hours of college credit are not required to take the SAT or ACT. These students, however, must take the appropriate placement examination and complete Learning Support requirements if necessary.

B. Transfer: *(a student with 30 or more semester hours (or 45 quarter hours) of transferable college credit)*

1. ___ Students should request official transcripts be sent directly to the EGC Admissions Office from EACH college attended (including technical). Transfer students must be eligible to return to the last college attended.

C. Transient: *(an applicant who is enrolled in another college or university and meets minimum EGC freshman or transfer admission requirements may seek temporary admission to EGC.)*

1. ___ Students should request a letter be sent directly to the EGC Admissions Office from the registrar of the institution in which the student is regularly enrolled, indicating a good standing and recommending admission to EGC as a transient student. (Transcripts of college work completed elsewhere are not required of transient students since they are not admitted to degree programs at EGC.)

D. Adult, Non-Traditional Students:

1. ___ Special Admission for Adult, Non-Traditional Students: Applicants for adult, non-traditional admission must have been out of high school or college for at least five (5) years and those applicants who attended college must have earned fewer than 30 semester hours of transferable college credit.

E. Career Program with Heart of Georgia Technical College, Ogeechee Technical College, Sandersville Technical College, Southeastern Technical College, and Swainsboro Technical College.

1. ___ Submit an official transcript showing graduation from an accredited high school or an earned GED diploma.
2. ___ Applicants will need to take the Compass exam to determine placement.
3. ___ If previously enrolled in one of the technical colleges listed above, submit an official transcript showing graduation and type of diploma received.
4. ___ Transfer applicants should submit a written request to the registrar of each college (including technical) attended asking that an official transcript of course work be mailed directly to the East Georgia College Office of Admissions.
5. ___ SAT or ACT scores, Regents requirements, or completion of the College Preparatory Curriculum is NOT required for career programs.

F. Readmission of Former East Georgia College Students

1. ___ Students who were previously enrolled at East Georgia College but who have not attended for two or more semesters must reapply for admission through the Registrar's Office.
