How to Apply:

Applicants to EGC must submit the following:

- Completed Application for Admission
- \$20 Application Fee (*non-refundable*)
- Signed and Completed Immunization Form
- Official High School Transcripts showing graduation from an accredited High School
OR
- Official GED Transcript
- Official Transcripts from all Colleges or Technical Schools
- SAT or ACT scores (*if applicable*)

Testing Information:

Students who do not have SAT or ACT test scores or are deficient in English and Math, are required to take the Compass Placement Exam.

Students who graduated 2010 and later who present a score of 235 or higher in the English Language Arts (ELA) section of the Georgia Graduation Exam will be able to exempt the Writing and Reading sections of the Compass Exam.

The Compass Placement Exam is given at the Swainsboro campus Monday through Thursday 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM and Friday 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM. Students that have taken the Exam elsewhere will

need to have their scores sent to the Admissions Office. Students who have not taken the Exam have the option of testing at a Remote Testing Site located in their area, which can be scheduled through the Admissions office.

Applicants for Fall Semester 2012 will have to meet additional requirements of:

Writing	—	32
Algebra	—	20

Students who are placed in all three areas **and/or** do not meet the minimum score will not be guaranteed admission; however each applicant will be reviewed and considered for Admission to East Georgia College.

Lawful Presence:

The Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia now requires all applicants to USG institutions to provide proof of Lawful Presence in the United States in order to be classified as In-State for tuition purposes. This change is effective immediately for all applicants for Fall Semester 2011, and subsequent semesters.

You **MUST** prove lawful presence in the United States in **ONE** or more of the following ways before you can be classified as an In-State student:

- Your completed FAFSA for the current financial aid year.
- A certified copy of your U.S. Birth Certificate showing that you were born in the U.S. or a U.S. territory. (*A Photocopy is NOT acceptable!*)
- Copy of your current Driver's License issued by the State of Georgia after January 1, 2008
- Copy of your current ID issued by the State of Georgia after January 1, 2008. Copy of your current U.S. Passport
- Present your Military ID *Service Member only, not dependent (A Photocopy is NOT acceptable!)*
- Copy of your Permanent Resident Card (USCIS form I-151 or I-551)
- Copy of your U.S. Certificate of Naturalization (USCIS form N-550 or N-570).
- Copy of your U.S. Certificate of Citizenship (USCIS form N-560 or N-561).

If you do not provide any of the above documentation, you will be classified an Out of State Student, must pay Out of State fees, and will be ineligible to attend the Statesboro Center.

Financial Aid Information

Applicants seeking Financial Aid will need to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid online at www.fafsa.gov listing East Georgia College on the application (Federal School Code --- 010997) by the financial aid deadline for the anticipated term of enrollment. Students who are applying for HOPE only will need to complete the HOPE Scholarship Request form (GSFAPPS) online at www.gacollege411.org. Students wishing to receive federal financial aid must be in a degree seeking admission category at East Georgia College.
