Overflow Student Update

If you are, or know, an **overflow student**, we will be starting to relocate female overflow students to regular room spaces this week. At this time we do not have any vacant male spaces and will not be able to relocate any male overflow students for the foreseeable future. If that changes, I will reach out and let you know.

Open Room Change Period

Open room change begins next week. This means that during this week will accommodate any room change request (space permitting) regardless of the reason. We will be able to accommodate a limited amount of room changes for female students, and room swaps only for male students. Because we don't have any vacant male spaces, room swapping will be the only option for students seeking a room change. Remember that you must try to work through any roommate differences first through a roommate mediation if the reason you are relocating is due to living difficulties. We cannot guarantee your next room assignment will be any better, so it is important to try your best to compromise when possible.

Clubs and Organizations Day


