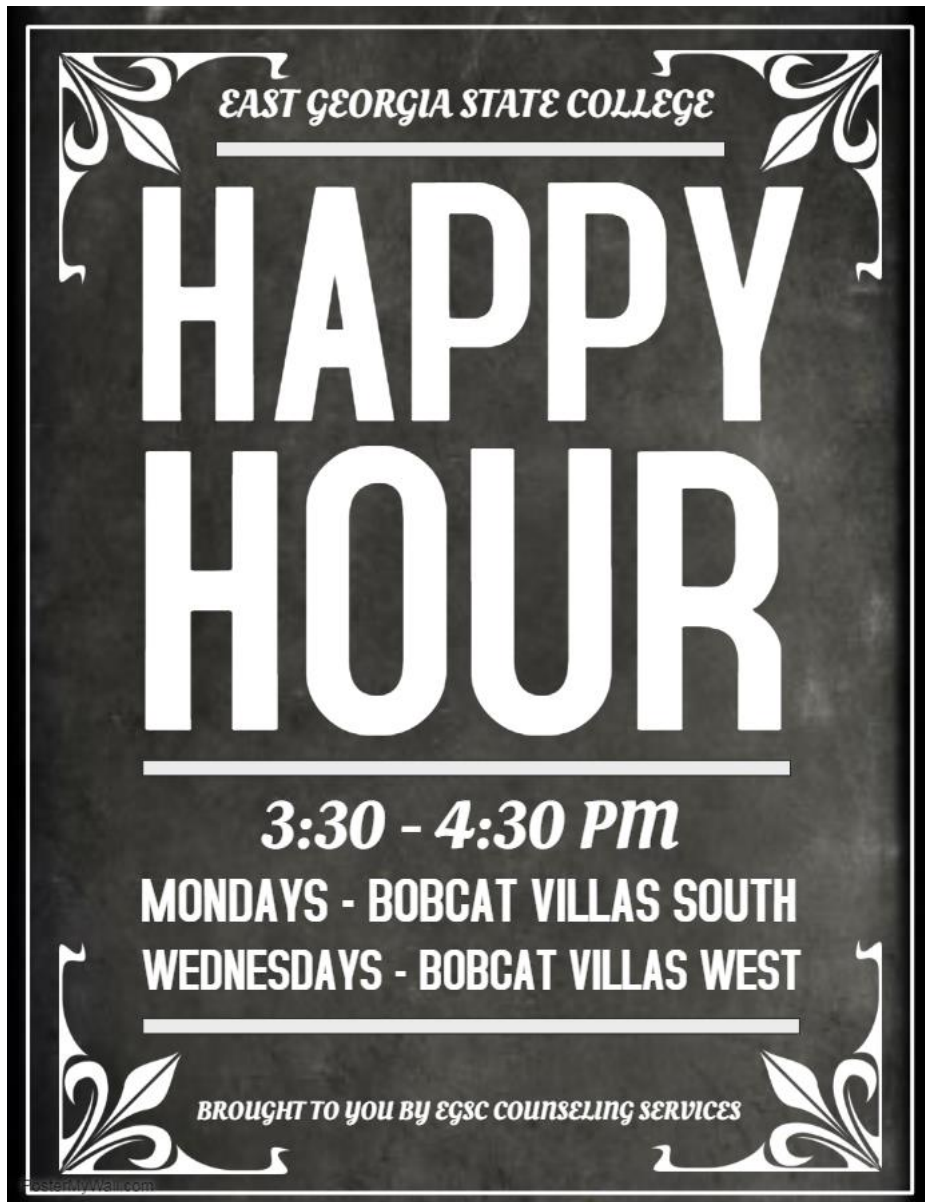

Don't have a car and need to get downtown on the weekend? A new bus system is here to meet your needs. EGSC students with a valid Cat Card can board the bus during the time periods listed

to go to the shopping center, Walmart, or downtown to the square. The times and drop off locations are very firm so make sure you make plans to board and return within the listed time frames.
