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### **10 Tips for College Students to be Successful**

- 1) Check your EGSC email daily! Don't miss the important information and deadlines that are sent out via email. EGSC's CATMAIL is the official means of communication for EGSC.
- 2) Obtain your parking pass (Swainsboro and Statesboro Campus) or bus pass (Statesboro Campus) before classes begins. Tickets will be submitted to all vehicles without an EGSC hang tag and you will not be permitted on the EGSC bus without a bus pass.
