This will be one of the most unusual and entertaining programs we have ever had at EGC. The Shouters perform one of the oldest African American traditions in North America - the ring shout - a practice that was documented in Antebellum times and was thought to have disappeared until a small church group in rural McIntosh County was discovered to be continuing the old tradition which incorporates indigenous African and Christian elements. We are fortunate to have

the Shouters perform for us. The Shouters have performed all over the country, including Lincoln Center in New York, and they have been documented in film and recordings.
