## Health and Safety Inspections

### *Week of March 5-9*

Housing professional staff will be visiting your unit on March 5-9 to conduct health and safety inspections. Make sure you address the following items before that time:

- Do any dishes that are laying around.
- Take out all the trash.
- Clean up your bathrooms and kitchen.
- Do your laundry or pick your clothes up and put them in the hamper.
- Make sure you don't have anything lying around that could attract bugs.

The specific date and time of your inspection will be placed on your main apartment door at least 48 hours prior to the inspection.

We are doing this so that you only have one place you need to visit to take care any of your housing business. ## Housing Room Renewal

### *Beginning after Spring Break*

**Are you a current resident of Bobcat Villas who intends to return to live on campus next year?** We will begin signing students up for rooms soon after spring break! Keep an eye out for the publicity and fliers that will be going up in the halls. We'll also be sending emails about the new housing application process.

### What you should know for this upcoming year:

- The deposit is going away, but students will now be required to pay a **\$100 non-refundable housing application fee**. We wanted you to know so that you could plan to have that money at the time you fill out your renewal application!
- **The housing application will be 100% online** thanks to our new Housing Database called StarRez! This means you can do everything in one quick online transaction, including paying your housing application fee!
- We will have **"how to" videos posted on our housing website** that will explain the new housing application from start to finish. More information is coming soon!
