HOUSING MOVE OUT

All residential students MUST move themselves and all of their belongings out of their apartment by Sunday, May 12 at 5 p.m. You must complete the check out process by **turning in your keys AT THE CLUBHOUSE!** Students who leave without checking out with a professional staff member will be charged \$50 for improper check out and \$25 for each key not returned.

Keep an eye out on your apartment door for important information about the check out process. Several items will be posted door to door in the coming weeks. Review the attachment on this email for more information and contact housing if you have any questions or concerns.

Important things to Remember:

- Students wanting a STANDARD MOVE OUT INSPECTION need to sign up at least 24 hours in advance of their anticipated move out time. Sign up in the clubhouse.
 - All students who are not continuing for Maymester must have all belongings and trash moved out by Sunday, May 12 at 5pm as well as keys turned in to the clubhouse.
 - Any student who moves out past May 12 at 5pm will be charged a \$50 improper move out fee! Don't be late!
 - All buildings wipe access will be deactivated for all but summer school students at this time.
 - Remember to clean out your fridge, take out all garbage, and clean your apartment (including common spaces) to avoid unnecessary fines and fees.
 - If you have questions, please stop by the clubhouse or give us a call at 478.289.2172 or email housing@ega.edu.
 - If you are loading in front of south, please get as close to the curb as possible and DO NOT double park on both sides of the street. Cars need to be able to get by.
