Voting is an important part of your civic duty, and EGSC is working to make it a little easier for you. If you are a registered voter in Emanuel County and you don't have transportation, take advantage of the Shopping Shuttle stop at the early voting location for Swainsboro. Make sure you get on the bus early because the polls close at 5pm. The bus will depart at 4pm and take you directly to the early voting location. Wear your mask and use social distancing while at the polls.

In other news, as a member of the COVID-19 response team, I constantly monitor COVID 19 reports from students, staff, and faculty. As many parts of our country enter a second or third wave, so too are we seeing an uptick in reports of possible COVID-19 cases here at EGSC.

Even if a student doesn't test positive, the quarantine process is something we don't want you to have to endure unnecessarily. Be sure to keep taking the following steps to keep yourself healthy.

- Wear masks at all times outside of your apartment. (Includes hallways, lounges, laundry rooms, lobby, etc.)
- If your masks have seen better days and you need new ones, come see me! I have a lot of extras and I am happy to help you replenish your supply.
- Continue using the hand sanitizer stations and let me know if you see any getting low so we can restock.
- Keep social distancing. It works!
- Lastly, remember to monitor yourself and report if you think you might have COVID symptoms. Do not let fear of a possible quarantine keep you from keeping yourself and other safe.
