Interim Policy on Revised Position Titles and Unit Names Due to Reorganization 4/16/18

Adopted by President's Cabinet 4/17/18

This policy is intended to provide interim guidance and direction concerning recent changes in position titles and unit names. The interim guidance will remain in place until replaced or revoked.

East Georgia State College conducted an internal reorganization as part of its budget reduction plan for FY 2018 and FY 2019. The plan was effective January 3, 2018. As a result of the reorganization, various position titles and unit names were revised as follows:

- The School of Humanities and the School of Social Sciences were consolidated to form the School of Humanities and Social Sciences. The former Dean of the School of Social Sciences leads the combined schools under the new position title "Dean of the School of Humanities and Social Sciences." The position "Dean of the School of Humanities" was eliminated.
- Academic Affairs and Student Affairs were consolidated to form the Office of Academic and Student Affairs. The former Vice President for Academic Affairs leads the combined office under the new position title "Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs." The position "Vice President for Student Affairs" was eliminated.

All EGSC policies, committees, webpages, documents, signage and other materials will be revised over the next several months. In the interim, unless expressly stated otherwise, the following rules of interpretation and substitution will apply as of January 3, 2018:
