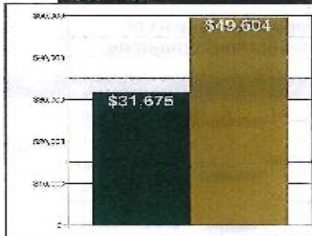

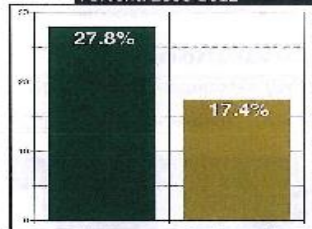

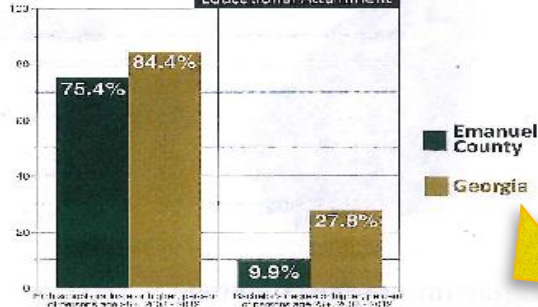
Median Household Income

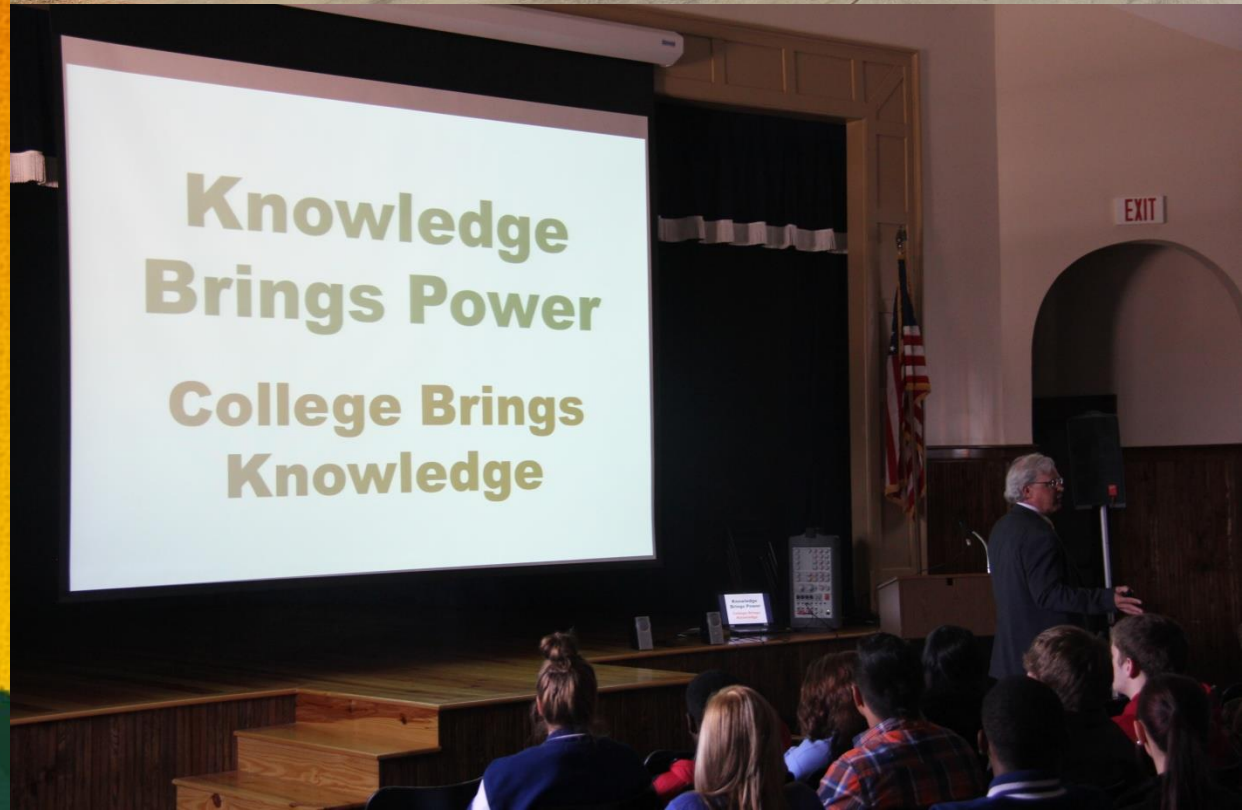

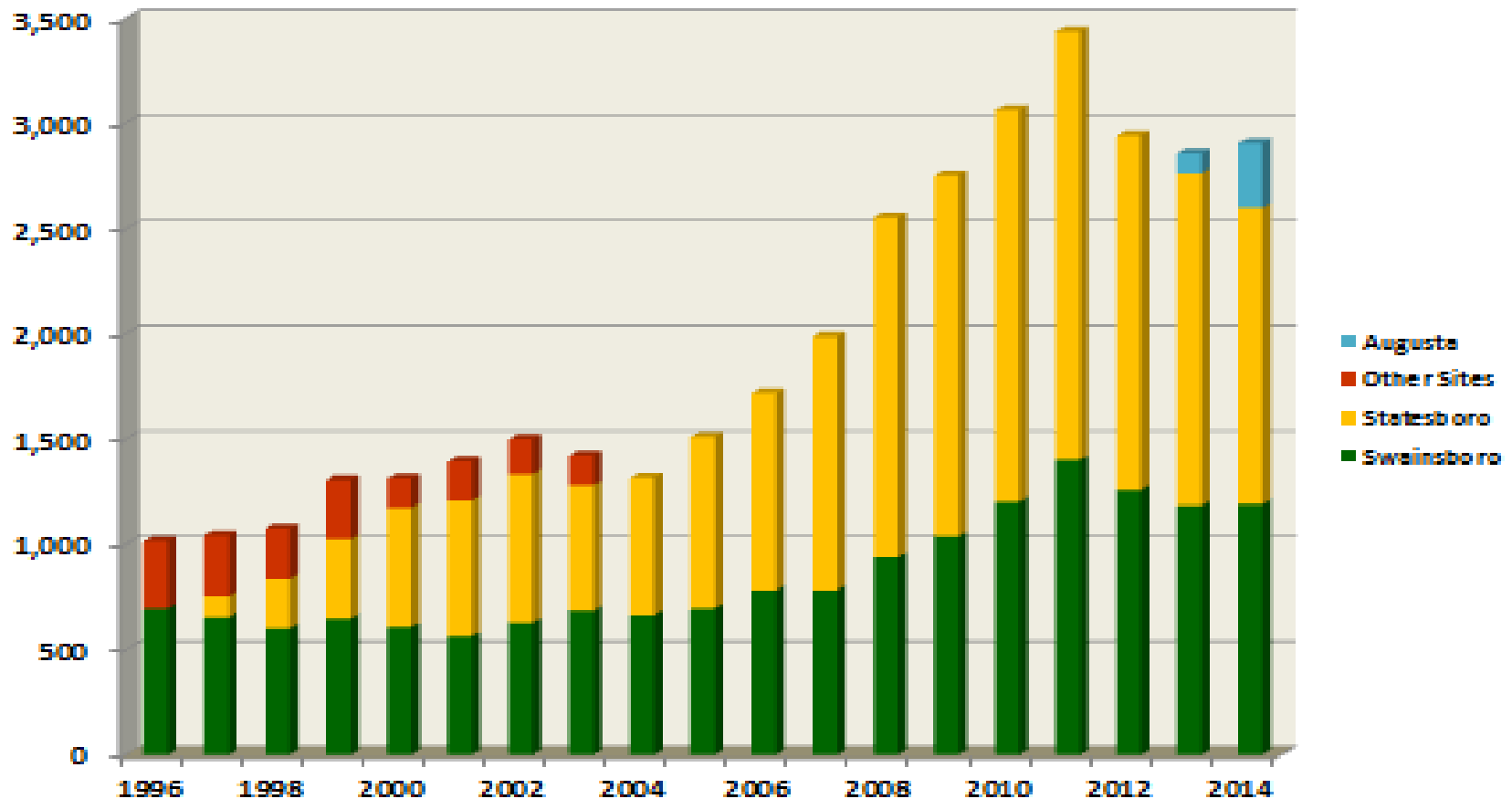

- Candidates will be announced in early Spring following interviews

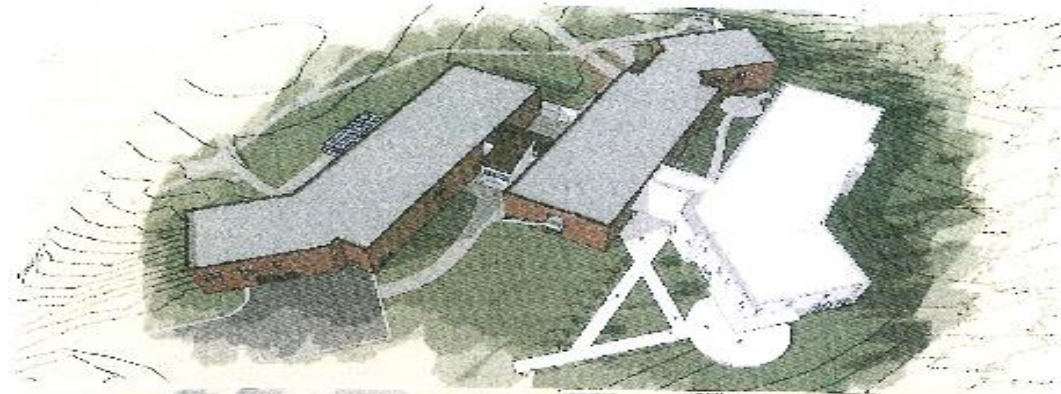

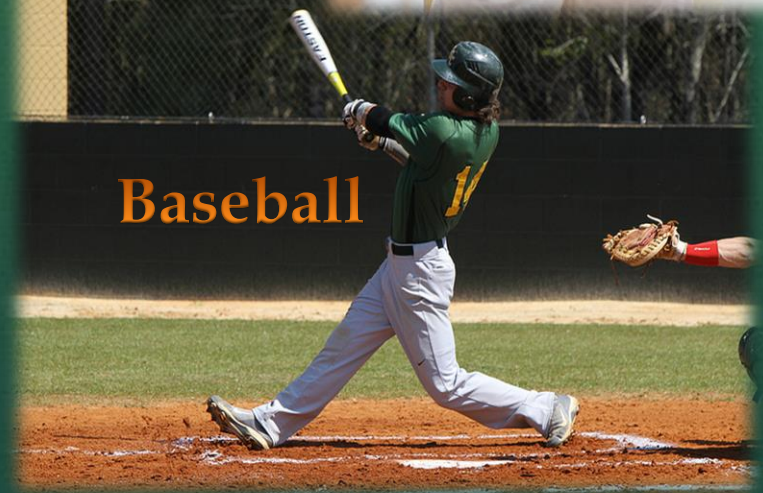
