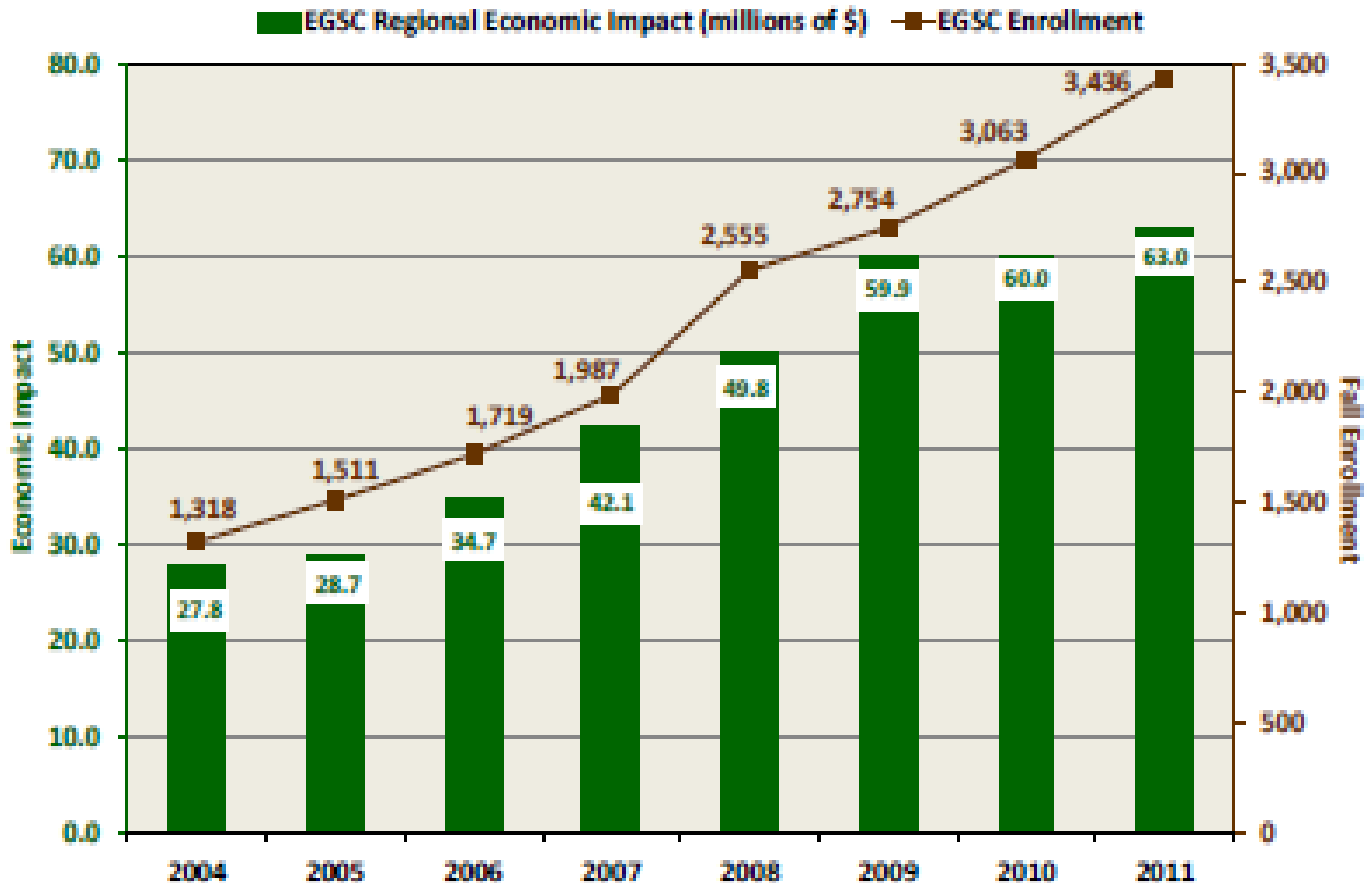

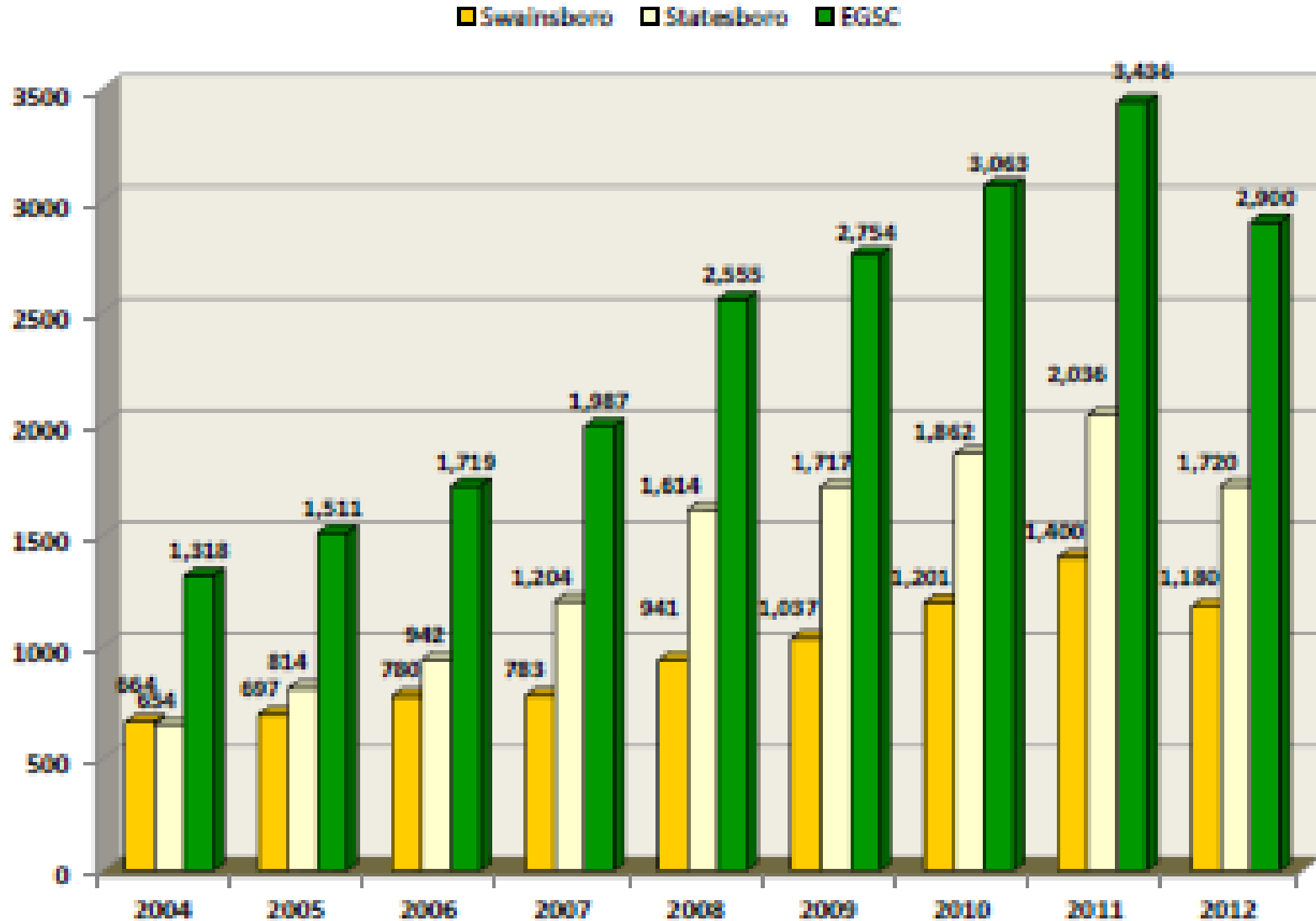

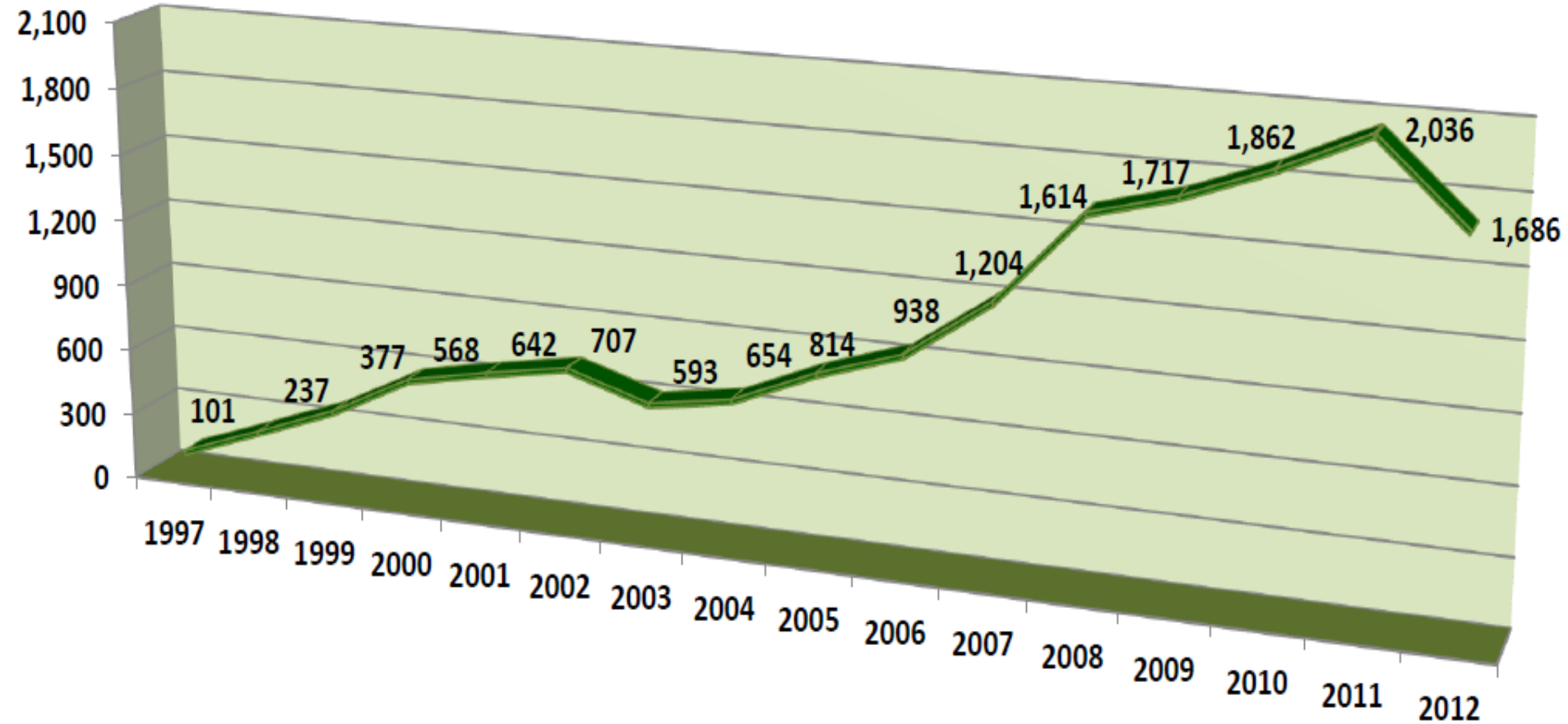
East Georgia State College's Regional Economic Impact and Enrollment Growth

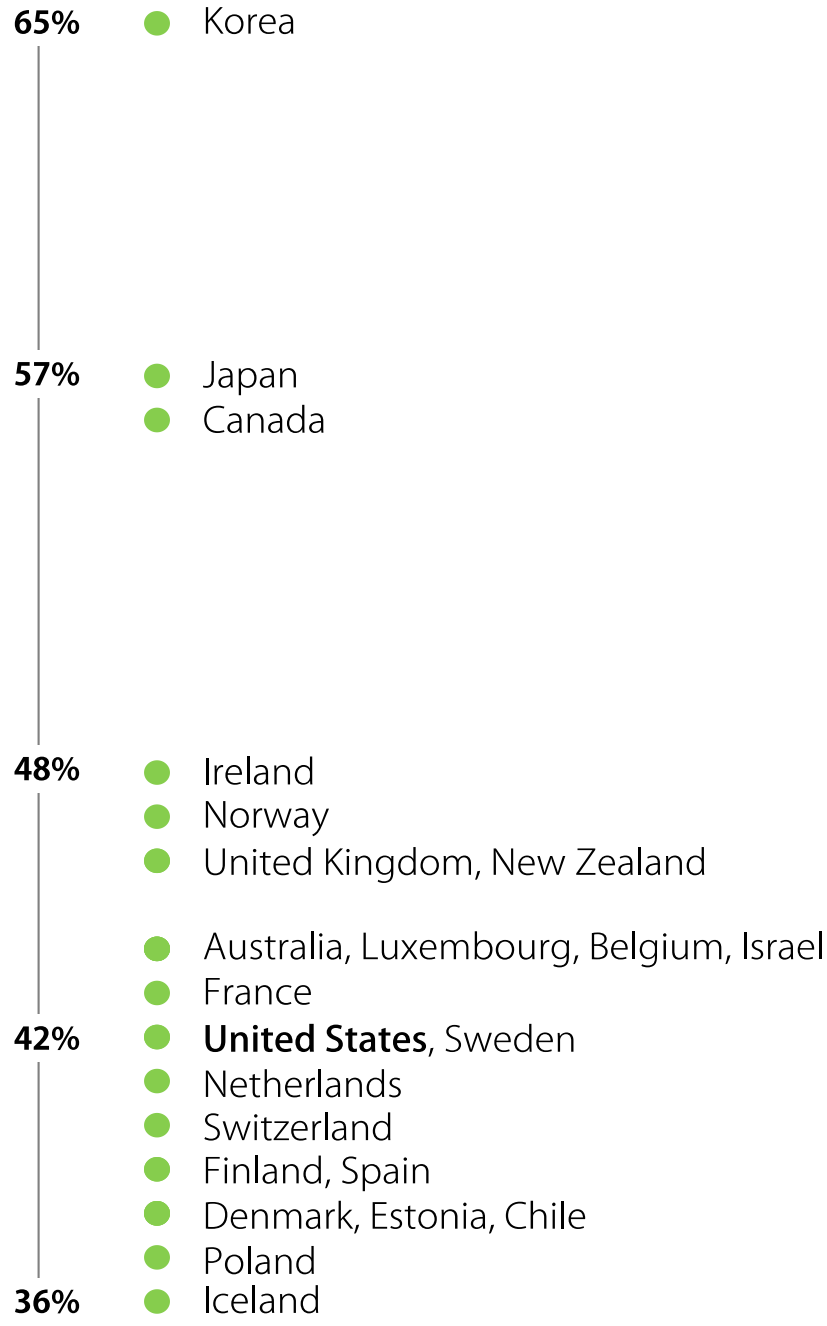

 - Availability of Federal Student Financial Aid
 - Space to offer programs
 - Economy of the region

 - Availability of student housing



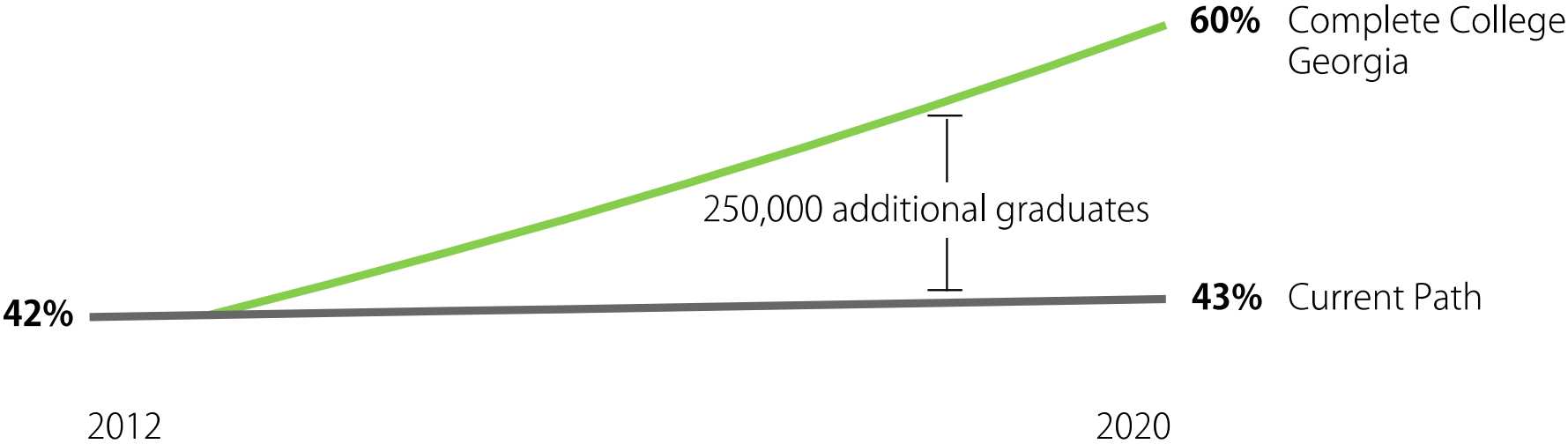
The United States is not keeping pace with anticipated need for higher education attainment.

By 2020, it's anticipated that 60% of jobs will require some form of higher education (certificate, associate's, bachelor's).
