The following items are necessary to compile an admissions package for Home Schooled applicants to East Georgia State College.

Application for Admission
Official transcripts from any conventional public/private high school and colleges attended with a 2.0 academic grade point average in College Preparatory Curriculum.
If you are a homeschool applicant with credits from non-accredited institutions and curriculum providers, you must submit the following:
Completed Home School College Preparatory Credit Evaluation Form (see page 6 of this guide) AND the following:
A detailed description of course work completed in each subject area of the 17 Required High School Curriculum (RHSC). Each description should include the subject title, course description, texts or program used and primary teacher. English Courses should include reading list. (See page 7 of this guide)
More documentation and or testing may be requested for admission consideration. Each subject should be representative of one Carnegie Unit (or academic year) of study.
ne school applicants who receive a General Education Development (GED) Diploma will need to submit al passing GED scores as well as a Home School Portfolio for Required High School Curriculum ation.

For all applicants:

Your completed application package should be submitted to the East Georgia State College Office of Admissions prior to the deadline for the term in which you are applying.

The Admissions Committee will review all transcripts, course descriptions and work submitted for RHSC compliance and at its sole discretion can recommend that an applicant has met some, all or none of the RHSC requirements.
